He is also vice chairman of the World Economic Forum, Chairman Emeritus of the Business Roundtable and member of the WEF Foundation Board of Trustees and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) Corporation. His many honors include the Grand Cordon of the Order of the Rising Sun, Japan’s highest award to others than members of the Imperial Family, and heads of state; the Islamic Republic of Pakistan’s Sitara-i-Eisaar award for humanitarian relief; the Presidential Distinguished Service Award for contributions to health services in Uganda and the United Nations Association of the United States of America’s Global Leadership Award, among others.
